STUDENT DRIVING/PARKING GUIDELINES

Driving to school is a privilege allotted to those students following the regulations governing the conduct of student drivers on campus. The school reserves the right to revoke a student's driving privilege if the student fails to adhere to any of these regulations. Students are not permitted to drive on any unpaved area except for the designated parking area located by the Kraikit Athletic Field.

- **Each student driver is required to purchase a \$50 parking permit. Students will be issued a window decal that must be placed inside the back window facing outward on the bottom right.**
- Student cars must be parked in the area designated for their class. Students must drive slowly on campus, never exceeding 15 mph.
- When entering or leaving the school grounds, music must not be played at a level heard outside the vehicle.
- Students are prohibited from using car horns for any reason other than imminent danger.
- Seniors are granted the privilege of parking in the senior circle (oval parking lot located adjacent to the gymnasium).
- Underclassmen are granted the privilege of parking in the first paved lot.
- ALL overflow parking is designated along the Kraikit Athletic Field fence line behind the Concession Stand.
- Cars should be parked facing forward. Please do not back into parking spaces.
