SENIOR PRIVILEGES

Trinity-Byrnes Collegiate School seeks to help with the transition to college by extending freedoms and privileges during the senior year which are similar to those experienced by college students. With permission from parents, seniors are allowed to have lunch off campus, however, they must sign out and back in at the front office.

Seniors are permitted to leave campus during a regularly scheduled study hall period providing the study hall falls either the period preceding or immediately following lunch. Additionally, seniors are allowed to arrive at school after a study hall that falls during the first period of the day, but must sign in prior to their 2nd period class. Seniors may sign out early for the day for study halls falling during the last period of the day.

Seniors who do not fulfill his or her obligations will have senior privileges revoked for such time as determined by the administration. These obligations include meeting academic and behavioral standards, class attendance, required meetings, and completing the requirements of the College Counseling Office.
